



# BUSCH CREEK DISC GOLF COURSE AT BURGER PARK



## DISC GOLF RULES & ETIQUETTE

DISC GOLF IS PLAYED LIKE REGULAR GOLF, USING A DISC. ONE STROKE IS COUNTED EACH TIME THE DISC IS THROWN & WHEN A PENALTY IS INCURRED. THE WINNER IS THE PLAYER WITH THE LOWEST SCORE.

NEVER THROW WHEN PLAYERS OR PARK USERS ARE WITHIN RANGE. ALWAYS GIVE PARK USERS THE RIGHT OF WAY. BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS.

EACH HOLE BEGINS WITH A TEE THROW. A PLAYER MUST BE WITHIN OR BEHIND THE DESIGNATED TEE AREA WHEN THE DISC IS RELEASED.

THE PLAYER WITH THE LEAST NUMBER OF STROKES ON THE PREVIOUS HOLE IS THE FIRST TO TEE OFF ON THE NEXT HOLE. AFTER TEEING OFF, THE PLAYER WHOSE DISC IS FARTHEST FROM THE BASKET ALWAYS THROWS FIRST.

THE LIE IS THE SPOT WHERE THE PLAYER'S PREVIOUS THROW HAS LANDED. MARK LIE WITH A MINI DISC IN FRONT OF THE THROWN DISC, OR JUST LEAVE THE THROWN DISC DOWN. A DISC THAT COMES TO REST ABOVE THE PLAYING SURFACE IS MARKED DIRECTLY BELOW THE DISC.

FAIRWAY THROWS MUST BE MADE FROM DIRECTLY BEHIND THE LIE. A RUN-UP AND NORMAL FOLLOW-THROUGH, AFTER RELEASE, IS ALLOWED, UNLESS THE LIE IS WITHIN 10 METERS (33 FEET) OF THE BASKET.

ANY SHOT WITHIN 10 METERS (33 FEET) OF THE BASKET IS A PUTT. NO CONTACT BEYOND THE LIE IS PERMITTED. A PLAYER MUST DEMONSTRATE FULL CONTROL OF BALANCE BEFORE ADVANCING PAST THE LIE.

A DISC THAT COMES TO REST IN THE BASKET OR CHAINS CONSTITUTES SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THAT HOLE.

A THROW THAT LANDS OUT OF BOUNDS MUST BE PLAYED 1 METER (3 FEET) FROM WHERE THE DISC WENT OB. A THROW IS CONSIDERED OB IF ANY AREA OF OB IS VISIBLE BETWEEN THE DISC AND OB LINE. ONE OB PENALTY STROKE IS ADDED.

ALWAYS STAND BEHIND THE PLAYER WHO IS THROWING. REMAIN QUIET AND AVOID UNNECESSARY MOVEMENTS WHILE OTHERS ARE THROWING.

DO NOT ALTER THE COURSE IN ANY WAY. (TREES, BUSHES, ETC.) PICK UP YOUR TRASH, AND LEAVE THE COURSE CLEANER THAN YOU FOUND IT.
