Originals and/or copies of agenda items of the meeting, including recorded votes are available on record in the office of the Public Works Department for one year. Video/DVD and audio tapes are kept only until the minutes have been approved for the meeting. DVD copies of this meeting are distributed to Board Members if requested.

The Board recognizes that there are not enough voting members present to have a quorum, so this meeting would be for information purposes and to keep the viewing citizens up-to-date on projects. It was stated that the Board members present could not vote on any actions. The Board members that are present can give their statements if they agree or disagree with an item, but that an actual vote cannot be taken.

The approval of the minutes was tabled until April 9, 2019 meeting.

Public Works Director John Nilges gave an update on Water and Wastewater – The new vactor truck is still being prepped over in Illinois and should be here soon. Council did allow us to proceed with purchasing the demo truck. A check was cut last Thursday so the truck will soon be on the way.

Wastewater - Two (2) new pumps set out at the landfill. Kevin says that about every five (5) years with leachate, everything essentially rusts out and decay to a point they have to be replaced. These were installed last week and is running like a new landfill. Kevin is getting the storm water pump down at the Locust St. Lift Station. This should be up and running with in the next 3 months. This will help out with our next large rainfall event.

Tiemann and Front Street – The reason for the pipes laying out is for the pumps that failed in the dry well, this is being repaired.

Construction has begun on Well #9, foundation has been poured, walls are already to be set. Trusses have all been delivered. Insurance did come through and dollars are in hand.

Mr. Darren Lamb has two (2) items for discussion.

Code revisions have been gone through prior to the end of 2018. Mary Trentmann lead this up with all department heads. A couple of items that needed to be looked at in the Chapters with regards to Public Works. These were put on hold till City Attorney Mark Piontek was able to take a good look at and review. So on Monday's Agenda for the Council there will be two ordinances.

The first being, before John came to work for the City. The City knew they were going to have to have a Public Works Director. When we went through the process of hiring a City Engineer the question was raised in those interviews that this position would change into the Public Works Director. Everyone understood this at the time John was going into the interview stage.

Once this was finished there were still some concerns with regards to what it would be called. We never had a public work director by ordinance and Mark said there were some things that would need to be looked at within the ordinance on the books in order for us to make this change.

John was promoted to Public Services Director and that was about two years ago so Public Services Director was created which I felt was a confusing title that could mean many things. This was put on a back burner. Honestly, things were functioning just fine for years as they were. So when Mary wanted to make changes to the codes we wanted them to go ahead and have this change made and take a look at.

There are two (2) ordinances that will be in front of the Council Monday night. The first is to change the designation of the Director of Public Services, it renames that position to Public Works Director and establishes a supervisory change.

What this does is sets it up to how we have been operating. John is our Public Works Director at this time but he will supervise the following positions, Streets, Sanitation Superintendent, Water and Wastewater Superintendent, Building Official, Airport Manager, City Engineer and City Assistant Engineer. So all of those reports through that Public Works Director and that the chain of command. We have been operating as such, it just wasn't on paper.

The second ordinance Mark Piontek our City Attorney looked at this ordinance for us and then he needed to make some changes. He said this would enact another chapter that matches state law.

Some provisions gave the Board of Public Works Supervisory authority over certain employees which authorities is not found in State law. Other changes were more cosmetic changes just language. It still provides for a water and wastewater superintendent which is Kevin. So this does not change. This can still go before the Board to appoint a superintendent. Mark went through and made changes based on state law. We have not looked at this section in a very long time. This is why Mary went through and made all the changes before the end of December.

So, I just wanted to bring these to you before you read them in the paper. John and I have been in discussion about these and wanted to make sure the Board was aware. Just the point of the Board of Public Works and the relationship of the Board of Public Works to water and wastewater. It was reiterated, nothing changes. Nothing changes but when you look at the title of the Director of the Board of Public Works and the Chain-of-Command. I do not think anything changes but to me there does not seem to be any wording that says the Board of Public Works monitors the operations of water and wastewater as the Director of Public Works. This is really not a change in the functionality.

We will forward through email copies of the ordinances for you to review. This all has been discussed with Kevin two or three weeks back and also spoke with Kevin yesterday where I think he understands since we have been operating this way the entire time.
