The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

4A 19-03-004 Trucks cutting through and using Jefferson and Front Streets. The downtown streets should not be a truck route. Those trucks are damaging the infrastructure. They should use the route the rest of trucks do, Hwy 100/Bluff. Review of ordinance was requested.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 5A 19-04-0001 It was brought to my attention that there is no road sign at the top of West Main Street saying that the street dead ends or street not thru. This may not be going anywhere but I think for safety reasons it would be good to have a sign. There have been several times that our truck drivers waiting to get into our receiving bay were close to being hit by a car. Cars are constantly driving nonstop down here just to turn around to go back up the hill.
- 5B 19-04-0002 Speed on Steutermann Road. Public Works employees have been working on the Well House and have witnessed excessive speeds on multiple occasions. We may need to look at enforcement for safety reasons.
