The next meeting of the Washington Traffic Commission will be held on August 7, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. in city council chambers.

The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

4A 20-06-0009 Complaint letter from citizen in reference to commercial vehicles: Engineering received a complaint from a citizen in reference to commercial vehicles violating city code in the area of E 5th Street.

4B 20-06-0010 Request for handicapped parking in front of 24 W 2nd: The owner of Angelina's has requested this parking for their customers.

4C 20-06-0011 Traffic Complaints in the area of 14th street at Quail Run Subdivision: This complaint came from a resident who mentioned congestion from school drop off and dismissal as an ongoing issue that he feels is causing safety issues.

4D 20-06-0012 Complaints about parking on Third Parkway at East Lane Dr: A complaint was received in reference to parking near this stop sign causing site distance issues.

4E 20-07-0013 Request for the city to take over an alley light at 1212 E 3rd: This request was for the city to take the light over for maintenance.

4F 20-07-0014 Request for street light near 604 Hancock: This request is to add a street light in the alley near this address.

4G 20-07-0015 Parking complaints in the area of 1713 Madison Avenue: Request to paint curb near the fire hydrant at this address due to ongoing parking issues.

NEW BUSINESS:

5A 20-08-0016 Review of stop sign on Circle Drive: A citizen inquired about the stop sign on the alley at Circle Drive. It was mentioned that some motorists are stopping for the stop sign when it is not appropriate to do so.

5B 20-08-0017 Request for no parking on Locust Street: This request is for a no parking zone on the West side of Locust Street from the North side of Tenth Street to 150 feet North. This request came as a result of proposed development in the area.

5C 20-08-0018 Request to remove handicapped parking near the old Schroeder Drugs: This request is to remove the two handicapped parking spaces near that location.

5D 20-08-0019 Review of procedure for block party applications: Parks Department has requested a review of the current process for block parties on city streets.

5E 20-08-0020 Request for a speed limit reduction on 8th Street from 47 to Jefferson: This request came from a resident in the area who cited concerns about speed in combination with pedestrian traffic and cyclists in the area.

5F 20-08-0021 Request for new speed signage in the area of Rabbit Trail Drive and Lexington and Wenona: This request is to consider installing radar speed display signs in the area due to ongoing speed complaints.
