Residents of The City of Washington Effective October 1, 2020 Water Rate Change



On August 17th the City Council voted to approve a water rate increase.

Why the change?

The City of Washington has maintained the same rate since 2011. Current and future budget projections indicate a rate increase is necessary. This increase will allow for needed improvements such as... waterline replacement, water tower maintenance, fire hydrant maintenance among other improvements.

What is the new rate?

- A Service Charge to all active meters-\$7.00 per month
 Usage Rate-
- First 16,667 gallons \$2.25 per 1000 gallon
- Usage over 16,667 gallons \$1.55 per 1000 gallon
