The next meeting of the Washington Traffic Commission will be held on September 4, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. in city council chambers.

The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 4A 20-06-0010 Request for handicapped parking in front of 24 W 2nd Street: This request came from the owner of the business at that location. This item was left on the agenda to give engineering a chance to conduct a study on handicapped parking in the downtown area.
- 4B 20-06-0012 Parking complaints on Third Parkway at East Lane Drive: Complaints have been received in reference to vehicles being parked near the intersection causing a site distance issue. This item was left on the agenda so that engineering could look at the intersection from a site distance stand point.
- 4C 20-07-0013 Request for the city to take over an alley light at 1212 E 3rd: Engineering is in the process of developing a standardized form for these types of requests. This item will remain open so that the committee will have a chance to review the form once it is developed. It will then be used to review this request.
- 4D 20-07-0014 Request for a street light in the alley near 604 Hancock: Same status as the above item.
- 4E 20-08-0019 Review of procedure for block party applications: This item was discussed at the last meeting. Some changes are currently being made to the application form for these types of events. Once the form is complete, the committee will review and approve it's use.
- 4F 20-08-0021 Request for new speed signage in the area of Rabbit Trail Drive and Lexington/Wenona: This request was to consider radar controlled speed displays in the area due to ongoing complaints. Engineering is in the process of conducting a speed study. The committee will review the study when it is available.

NEW BUSINESS:

5A 20-09-0022 Speed complaints on West Ridge: Complaints have been received by residents in the area who are concerned about an ongoing speed issue.

5B 20-09-0023 Request for signage in the downtown area in public parking lots: Downtown Washington has requested that the city add signage at the entrances to public parking lots in the downtown area.
