The next meeting of the Washington Traffic Commission will be held on November 6, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. in city council chambers.

The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

4A 20-06-0010 Request for handicapped parking in front of 24 W 2nd Street: This request came from the owner of the business at that location. This item was left on the agenda to give engineering a chance to conduct a study on handicapped parking in the downtown area.

4B 20-07-0013 Request for the city to take over an alley light at 1212 E 3rd: Engineering is in the process of developing a standardized form for these types of requests. A draft form has been completed for review by the traffic committee.

4C 20-07-0014 Request for a street light in the alley near 604 Hancock: Same status as the above item.

4E 20-08-0021 Request for new speed signage in the area of Rabbit Trail Drive and Lexington/Wenona: This request was to consider radar controlled speed displays in the area due to ongoing complaints. At the last meeting, the committee reviewed results from a speed study that was conducted on these streets. The committee agreed at that time to hold off on making any decisions or recommendations until further data is collected through out town. Engineering is in the process of collecting speed data on numerous other city streets for comparison. When all of the data is collected, it will be presented and reviewed. This will likely take several months.
