The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

4A 20-06-0010 Request for handicapped parking in front of 24 W 2nd Street: This request came from the owner of the business at that location. Engineering has been in the process of reviewing current handicapped parking in the downtown area and assessing potential need. An update will be provided at this meeting.

4B 20-08-0021 Request for new speed signage in the area of Rabbit Trail Drive and Lexington/Wenona: Speed data has been collected for the streets mentioned. Before making a final decision, the traffic committee will review the results of an ongoing speed study that is being conducted by Engineering throughout town to compare those numbers to the data that has been collected for Rabbit Trail and Lexington/Wenona. This item will stay on the agenda until the ongoing study has been completed and discussed.

4C 20-11-0022 Complaints about site distance at Market and Main: A complaint was received from a citizen about vehicles parked on the West side of Market Street causing a site distance issue. Engineering was to take a look at the intersection from a site distance standpoint and will discuss their findings at this meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

5A 20-12-0023 Request for 2 hour parking signage on Elm Street: A request has been received to add two hour parking signage on Elm Street between Fourth and Third Streets.
