The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 4A 20-08-0021 Request for new speed signage in the area of Rabbit Trail Drive and Lexington/Wenona: Speed data has been collected for the streets mentioned. Before making a final decision, the traffic committee will review the results of an ongoing speed study that is being conducted by Engineering throughout town to compare those numbers to the data that has been collected for Rabbit Trail and Lexington/Wenona. This item will stay on the agenda until the ongoing study has been completed and discussed.
- 4B 21-01-0001 Review of truck route signage policy: It has been brought to our attention that a lot of the city's "No Truck Route" signs are in need of replacement. The committee discussed this matter and noted that currently the signage is spread out through town in what appears to be an arbitrary manner. The committee's goal will be to develop a standard policy to move forward with. Engineering is in the process of conducting a survey to locate all existing signage, which will then be reviewed by the committee before moving forward.

NEW BUSINESS:

5A 21-02-0002 Review of letter from residents about the intersection of 100 and Rabbit Trail: A letter has been received from the Lake Washington Board of Directors requesting that the city take a look at this intersection from a safety standpoint, especially considering the recent increase in traffic volume due to new development in the area.
