To Business Owner:

Welcome to the City of Washington!

Our Cigarette Permits are valid from March 1st to February 28 each year. They are to be assigned to only one place of business and must be displayed for the public to see.

In accordance with Chapter 620, section 620.080, it shall be the duty of every dealer or wholesaler, selling, offering or displaying for sale any package of cigarettes, to remit the monthly cigarette tax reporting form, in the format as prescribed by the City Collector, and full payment by the fifteenth (15th) day of each following month. The canceled check and copy of the monthly cigarette tax report, shall be proof of payment.

Record Requirements:

Each dealer and those wholesalers and retailers shall retain invoices showing the amount and value of the shipment of cigarettes received, the date, and the name of shipper. You must also keep records of cigarettes received, sold or delivered within the City. You must keep the invoices for a period of three (3) years subject to the use and inspection of the City Collector.

In 2013 the City of Washington passed the Smoke-Free Act.

This act prohibits smoking *in the following outdoor* public places:

•Ten (10) feet outside the main entrance and ventilation systems of enclosed areas where smoking is prohibited, so as to prevent tobacco smoke from entering those areas.

•Twenty (20) feet of bleachers and grandstands for use by spectators at sporting and other public events.

•Twenty (20) feet of, all outdoor playgrounds.

Smoking shall be prohibited *in all enclosed public places* within the City of Washington, Missouri, including, but not limited to, the following places:

Aquariums, galleries, libraries, and museums, Areas available to the general public in businesses and nonprofit entities patronized by the public, including, but not limited to, banks, laundromats, professional offices, and retail service establishments, Bars, Bingo facilities, Child care and adult day care facilities, Convention facilities, Educational facilities-both public and private, Elevators, Gaming facilities, Health care facilities, Hotels and motel (except in designated private rooms allowed for smoking and rented to guests), Lobbies, hallways, and other enclosed common areas in apartment buildings, condominiums, trailer parks, retirement facilities, nursing homes, and other multiple-unit residential facilities, Polling places, Public transportation vehicles, including buses and taxicabs, under the authority of the City, and ticket, boarding, and waiting areas of public transportation facilities, including bus, train, and airport facilities, Restaurants, Restrooms, lobbies, reception areas, hallways, and other common-use areas, Retail Stores, Rooms, chambers, places of meeting or public assembly, including school buildings, under the control of an agency, board, commission, committee or Council of the City or a political subdivision of the State, to the extent the place is subject to the jurisdiction of the City, shopping malls, Sports arenas, including enclosed places in outdoor arenas, Theaters and other facilities primarily used for exhibiting motion pictures, stage dramas, lectures, musical recitals, or other similar performances.

Smoking shall be prohibited in all enclosed areas of places of employment without exception.

This includes, without limitation, common work areas, auditoriums, classrooms, conference and meeting rooms, private offices, elevators, hallways, medical facilities, cafeterias, employee lounges, stairs, restrooms, vehicles, and all other enclosed facilities. This prohibition on smoking shall be communicated to all existing employees by the effective date of this Chapter and to all prospective employees upon their application for employment.
