OLD BUSINESS:

4A 21-03-0003 Lime Scooter status update: Committee will discuss any noted issues/complaints in involving Lime Scooters.

4B 21-04-0004 Speed complaints on Earth Crest Drive: This item was discussed at the last meeting. The committee is currently awaiting the results of a speed study that is being conducted.

NEW BUSINESS:

5A 21-05-0005 Review of block party/street closure request form: The committee will review the current form that is used to apply for block parties.

5B 21-05-0006 Request for street lighting in the 800 Block of West Main: This request came from a homeowner.

5C 21-05-0007 Request for four way stop at West Main and Tiemann: This request came from the same homeowner as the above. The complaint cited speed as a concern and also requested speed limit signage on their block.

5D 21-05-0008 Request for parking block stripes on Cedar Street North of West Main: This request came from a local business.

5E 21-05-0009 Site distance complaint at 5th and 47: A complaint was received in reference to poor site distance for vehicles attempting to turn North on 47 from WB 5th Street.

5F 21-05-0010 Review of No Parking Zones on South Lake Shore Drive: The committee will address the current parking situation on S Lakeshore as a result of ongoing issues with parking in the area.

5G 21-05-0011 Request for stop sign at Front and Jefferson: This request came from a resident, who cited poor site distance as a concern.

5H 21-05-0012 Parking complaint at Karen and Camp Street: This complaint came from a resident who lives in the area. He suggested that the Northwest corner of the intersection should be designated as No Parking.

5I 21-05-0013 Complaints about U Turns at Main and Oak: A business in the area has requested signage in the area to address vehicles making U Turns in the intersection.

5J 21-05-0014 Review of city codes on alternate types of vehicles: The committee will review the updated city codes that pertain to ATV's, UTV's, and golf carts on city streets.
