The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 4A 21-03-0003 Lime Scooter status update: Committee will discuss any noted issues/complaints in involving Lime Scooters.
- 4B 21-05-0007 Request for a four way stop at West Main and Tiemann: This request came from a resident in the area. At the last meeting, the committee reviewed a completed traffic study and agreed that there was no unique speed issue on this roadway segment. Engineering was in the process of taking a look at the width of the roadway and should have an update at this meeting.
- 4C 21-05-0014 Review of city codes on alternative types of vehicles: At the last meeting the committee reviewed the updated city codes pertaining to ATV's, UTV's, Utility Vehicles, and golf carts on city streets. This item was left on the agenda to allow staff to conduct further follow up to bring back to the committee.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 5A 21-07-0021 Request for "Children Playing" signage in the area of 909 West Fifth Street: This request came from the resident at that address.
- 5B 21-07-0022 Request for fire lane signage on the west side of the access road to the pool and Ronsick Field.
- 5C 21-07-0023 Request to add a parklet to city right of way: This request came from Downtown Washington. They are finishing construction on a parklet which they are requesting permission to place in an existing on street parking space downtown.
