

# Improvements & Changes

## to the City of Washington Bulk Trash Service, starting February 2022

### "Once a Month Collection"

#### **BULKY WASTE PICKUP (2-Items Each Month)**



#### **BULKY ITEM COLLECTION:**

##### **1. Residents serviced by dumpsters:**

- a. Third week in April & third week in October on the residences scheduled pickup day.

##### **2. All other residents:**

- a. Last scheduled collection date of each month. Each residence shall be allowed two (2) bulky items per month to be collected curbside.

(See defined terms listed below for clarification of bulky items & construction and demolition waste.)

#### **DEFINITION OF TERMS:**

**Bulky Item:** Any item measuring in excess of either forty-eight (48) inches in length or sixty (60) pounds in weight, including, but not limited to, chairs, couches, mattresses, box springs, tables, shelves, toys, bikes, outdoor/garden equipment, and other similar household items.

- **Bulky items does not include construction and demolition waste, auto parts, tires, and hazardous materials.**
- **All other residential trash must be contained in accordance with City Code. Loose trash will not be picked up**

**Construction and Demolition Waste:** Solid Waste such as wood, bricks, flooring, roofing materials, etc., that is directly or indirectly the by-product of such activities, including, but not limited to, cartons, concrete, excelsior, gypsum board, metal, paper, plastic, rubber and wood products. Solid Waste such as wood, bricks, flooring, roofing materials, etc., that exceeds 35 gallons in volume or 50 pounds in total weight, or not in a container, or is over 48 inches in length is Construction and Demolition Waste.
