OLD BUSINESS:

4A 22-10-0019 Portable 25mph signs: The committee discussed the current placement of our portable 25mph speed limit signage. The committee agreed to move the current signage to Lexington Lane in reference to the complaint below, in addition to Karen Lane. (OPEN)

NEW BUSINESS:

5A 22-11-0020 Speed complaint on Lexington Lane: A complaint was received from a resident who lives at 20 Lexington in reference to ongoing speed issues in the area. The committee discussed the complaint and reviewed a speed study that was conducted in 2020 on Lexington Lane in the area of Brookshire Lane. The committee noted that the speed study indicated a combined enforcement rating of 9.3% with an 85th percentile of 33mph. In comparing that speed study to the results from other locations, it ranked in the middle from a score/priority standpoint. The committee discussed applicable countermeasures, and agreed that at this time the only effective/appropriate countermeasures were additional enforcement along with the use of radar trailers and temporary signage. Mike Grissom will follow up with the resident. (CLOSED)
