**OLD BUSINESS:**

4A 22-10-0019 Portable 25mph signs: The committee discussed the current placement of our portable 25mph speed limit signage. Engineering will move the signs based on existing lists that they have. (OPEN)

**NEW BUSINESS:**

5A 23-01-0001 Request to operate ATV's on city streets: Resident Phil Marquart was present at the meeting and addressed the committee with a request to operate his ATV on city streets. The committee discussed Mr. Marquart's requested handicapped exemption and agreed to consult Mark Piontek about what a potential code amendment would look like to accommodate such a request. The committee will review the new proposed code amendment at the next meeting and make a formal vote. (OPEN)

5B 23-01-0002 Request for tenant parking in the area of 2<sup>nd</sup> and Elm: This request came from a resident who resides in the area. The committee discussed the request and reviewed available public parking in the area. The committee agreed that the public parking in the area was adequate and did not recommend removing the current 2 hour parking on the city street. (CLOSED)

5C 23-01-0003 Street closure request for W Main Street near Cedar: The Chamber of Commerce has requested permission to close the city street for a very short period of time for a ribbon cutting ceremony. The committee agreed that due to the very brief closure, no formal street closure request was needed. Street Department will drop off barricades and the Chamber will call the Police Department for help closing the street during the ceremony. (CLOSED)
