BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Washington, Missouri, as follows:	
SECTION 1: There is hereby levied and imposed for the calendar year 2023 for	general
municipal purposes a tax upon all real estate and taxable tangible property in the	City of
Washington, Missouri at the rate of \$0.7550 on the one hundred dollars assessed valuation.	
SECTION 2: The tax described in Section 1 hereof shall be divided as follows:	
(a) \$0.5641 on the one hundred dollars assessed valuation shall be set aside and uti	lized for
general revenue purposes of the City of Washington; and	
(b) 0.1909 on the one hundred dollars assessed valuation shall be set aside and uti	lized for
free public library purposes.
