The next meeting of the Washington Traffic Commission will be held on December 1, 2023 at 8:00 a.m. in City Council Chambers.

The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS:

4A 23-11-0046 Street light request at Westlink and Recycle Drive: This item was discussed at the last meeting and disposed of, however after the meeting city staff determined that there had been some confusion about the current city code. The matter will be revisited at this meeting.

4B 23-11-0048 Review of crosswalk on Third Street at Mercy: At the last meeting the committee discussed crosswalk and signage options with representation from Mercy Hospital. The item was left on the agenda for follow up at this meeting.

4C 23-11-0049 E 5th Street Traffic Concerns: At the last meeting, the committee was visited by residents who live along E 5th Street. Among the concerns discussed was the new development on E 5th Street across from Willows Court and how that development would be allowed to access 5th Street. At the time there were no clear answers on that subject. This item was left on the agenda to monitor access to 5th Street from that development.

NEW BUSINESS:

5A 23-12-0050 Crosswalk at Market and Front Street: The committee will discuss some ongoing issues with this crosswalk.

5B 23-12-0051 Main Street Community signage: The committee will discuss placement of additional signage recognizing the city as a state and nationally accredited main street community.

5C 23-12-0052 Sight distance review on Washington Avenue: The committee received a request to look at sight distance as a result of on street parking at 5th and Washington and 3rd and Washington.
