The following item(s) are presently on the agenda.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

4A 24-02-0004 Request for on-street parking on Oak Street: A resident has requested that we add on-street parking on the East side of Oak Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> and Main. This was discussed at the last meeting and Engineering is looking into making the West side of the street “No Parking” rather than the East side.

4B 24-02-0007 Review of loading zones: City staff is currently in the process of reviewing loading zones that are in city code. The goal is to clean up and remove any that are unnecessary.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

5A 24-03-0009 Request for two hour parking signage in the 200 block of Elm: This request came from a business owner in the area.

5B 24-03-0010 Sidewalk complaint on Rabbit Trail at Dukes Way: A resident has asked that the city better designate the sidewalk in this area.

5C 24-03-0011 Traffic complaints at 47 and 100: A citizen has voiced concern about red light violators at this intersection and plans to attend the meeting.

5D 24-03-0012 Legion loading request: A shuttle service that will be working the Legion Regionals from August 4-13 has requested designated on street stops on Front Street and Main Street.

5E 24-03-0013 Lime Scooter Request: The board from Downtown Washington has endorsed the idea of bringing back Lime Scooters to the downtown area.
