# **Minutes**

## **Priority Items**

Not a real priority but a discussion was brought up about water shut off's. The procedure now for water shut off's is to shut off residents that are past due 45 days are more (this cover's two past due amounts); Kevin would like the procedure to follow the City code of anyone late 15 days to be put on the shut off list. Currently bills are created the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month and due in twenty days. Penalties are added to a bill the day after the due date, the shut off date stated in the code book is 15 days after the due date. The discussion led to shut off's after 15 days needing to go to the City Council.

#### Wastewater

Discussion was made on the sewer break at the Railroad track a few days ago. The board discussed and praised the staff for the hard work to get the Railroad line back in full service. Staff from the waste water, water and street departments all worked to get the sewer line back and running.

#### Water

Update on the South Point Water Tower. There was a ribbon cutting was held on May 16<sup>th</sup>. Pay request to KJ Unnerstall Construction and Caldwell Tanks pay request were approved.
